Christian Gifts Outreach

Scout Sunday for the Cub and Boy Scouts in February went very well, with much participation during the Sunday 2/3 masses from the scouts and a nice recognition at the end of mass by Father. Girl Scout Sunday is planned for March 7th.

“Soup”er Bowl Sunday, the canned soup drive for Dare to Care Food Bank in Louisville, was a success. We collected two medium sized boxes of canned soups (I didn’t count them, but it was over 75 cans)and over \$230 in cash donations.

Our TOOL Lenten Food collection is still ongoing, through Easter. We haven’t really gotten enough to donate to a pantry yet, Oldham County Red Cross was the first on the list, to keep it more local, unless someone has another suggestion. Father Bill had indicated he had no specific intentions, just to call around and find where needs were.
